Sock Hop Swap

The Quilt Camp opening includes a Friendship Swap. Cut your favorite bright color fabric into fifty 5-inch squares. Bring them along and meet new people as you swap fabric strips. You'll have the beginning of a beautifully scrappy quilt and many wonderful friendships.
